IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS - SEF COVID-19

The Foreigners and Borders Service (SEF) has put in place a management plan for appointments that determines that, at the date of the declaration of the State of National Emergency (March 18), all foreign citizens with pending cases in SEF are in a situation of regular permanence in national territory.

This plan, determined by Order of the Minister of Internal Administration (Order No.3863-B/2020 of 27 March), also predicts the **closure of all SEF branches**, considering the need to reduce the risks to public health associated to face to face assistance, both at SEF workers and SEF users.

The documents that attest to the situation of regular stay in Portugal are:

- Document of expression of interest or request issued by the registration platforms in use at SEF (articles 88, 89 and 90-A)
- Document proving the scheduling at SEF or a receipt proving the order made (requests for concessions or renewals of residence permits)

These **proofs** are valid for all public services, namely for:

- Obtaining the National Health Service number
- Access to the National Health Service or other health care rights
- Access to social support benefits
- Sign of rent contracts
- Sign of employment contracts
- Opening bank accounts
- Hiring essential public services (water, electricity, gas)

Visas and documents relate to your stay in portugal that expired after february 24, 2020 are valid until june 30, 2020.

Sef will continue to provide face to face assistance only for urgent requests.

Sef will **reschedule the appointments** that were scheduled until march 27, **starting next july 1, in chronological order**.
